Gun Tool & Cleaning Kit	Basic kit, should you need to clear a malfunction etc. (screw driver, punches if required etc.)	
Light Medica <mark>l</mark> Kit	Your personal booboo kit. The ERSC have a trauma kit at the range always.	
Sun block	Generally advised.
